Starting March 2, 2015, the new IRP Online Self-Registration System will be available. Visit the Georgia Trucking Portal and apply for a password today!

The Georgia Trucking Portal offers a “one stop shop” for users to access all CVISN credentialing applications including:

- International Registration Plan (IRP)
- Georgia Intrastate Motor Carrier (GIMC)
- International Fuel Trade Agreement (IFTA)
- Trip/Fuel/Hunters Permitting
- Unified Carrier Registration (UCR)
- Oversize/Overweight Permitting

What are the benefits of using the new IRP Online Self-Registration System?

- Links directly to the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) website in order to request or update interstate or intrastate USDOT Numbers.
- IRP Registrations can be completed and submitted from the convenience of your home or office resulting in:
 - » Faster registration processing times.
 - » Avoiding long waits in the Motor Vehicle Division lobby.
 - » Saving on the cost of fuel and driving time to Atlanta from all over the State of Georgia.
