WORKING WITH SAWYER'S - LIMBING TOPPING.

- 1 Ensure visual contact with ground personnel at all times.
- 2 Ensure adequate distances are maintained from sawyers - at least ___ feet
- 3 What is the game plan for operators and ground personnel?
- 4 What is the Emergency response plan for all personnel? (Who responds to incident, makes call, speaks with emergency personnel, who is contacted?)
- 5 Communication between in-woods personnel, truck drivers, ground personnel and visitors (expected and unexpected)

WORKING WITH OTHER EQUIPMENT AND TRUCKING PERSONNEL

- 6 Approaching Equipment in Operation - Communication/Notification/Visibility
- 7 (Do not get off your machine until other operator signals)
- 8 Executing the Harvest Plan - Who is responsible for what

ELIMINATING AND REDUCING HAZARDS DURING THE HARVEST

- 9 Appropriate handling and resolution of snags/leave trees
- 10 Special attention to remove all overhead hazards
- 11 Removal and/or use, proper disposal of other hazards (debris, etc.)

SPECIFIC HAZARDS ASSOCIATED WITH FELLING WOOD ON SLOPES

- 12 At what point is the slope too steep to continue normal operation
- 13 Proper orientation to the slop in operation (Minimize positioning the machine horizontally)
- 14 Operation around high stumps and uneven ground
- 15 Placement of the deck/landing to maximize stability (Hazards to operators and ground personnel)

TRUCK AND TRAILER ENTRY AND EXIT TO LANDING/DECK AREA

- 16 Proper procedure for Driver and Loader Operator
- 17 Driver distance from Loader to be observed
- 18 Ground personnel behavior in Loading area
