In preparation for the SWPA Zoom Virtual workshops

If (you - the attendee) do not already have a Zoom account and in the days prior to the actual workshop day, make time to....

Download Zoom - <https://zoom.us/download> on the device you are planning to attend the SWPA Zoom Virtual workshop on - Remember: only 1 person per device. (If you are using a smartphone – go to the App store to install the Zoom application).

A device can be your desktop computer, laptop, tablet or smartphone that has a solid internet signal and connection.

Create a Zoom account (the basic version is free) It is best to create the account under the name of the person attending the SWPA Zoom Virtual workshop.

Each person attending the SWPA Zoom Virtual workshop needs a specific email address (you can use a spouse's email if you don't have an email address yourself - but remember to **log** into Zoom using your own name and the email you choose to use.) Why is this important? It's so you will receive credit for attending this workshop. Zoom provides a report of **WHO** was logged in and for **HOW** long they were logged in for.

Each year SWPA is audited (and you could be too) for adherence / attendance of Continuing Logging Education – SWPA will be using the reports from Zoom as the documentation that proves your attendance. If you are logged in under another name or multiple people viewing on one device – the Zoom report will only report attendance by that user/ email. Each attendee will also be required to type their name in the CHAT field (on Zoom) at beginning and end of the ZOOM workshop, as another method of verifying attendance.

After you have downloaded / installed Zoom and created your account - Test your device. Check your device's audio and video compatibility. Most likely - any changes will need to be completed on your end. Check the speaker volume levels, etc.

A few days before the actual date of the SWPA Zoom Virtual workshop I will send out an email (to the email you provided on your SWPA registration forms) that will provide a link to the specific Zoom Meeting invite. Although you cannot enter the actual Zoom meeting until 15 minutes before the workshop - you can practice muting and un-muting your microphone and become familiar with the Zoom screens.

Workshop day - 15 – 20 minutes before - select the Zoom Meeting link from the email I sent you. You will get a message “Waiting for Meeting to start” or “Waiting on Host” the host will join all attendees a few minutes before the workshop start time.

During the SWPA Zoom Virtual workshop - stay logged in, if you should lose connection – log back in as soon as possible. Each presenter has a different style/method and could take a Roll Call of Attendance during their presentation. And again, -each attendee will also be required to type their name in the CHAT field (on Zoom) at beginning and end of the ZOOM workshop, as another method of verifying attendance.

Once the workshop has ended – and the Zoom report has loaded, been reviewed and confirmed I will email out the Certificates of credit / hours attended along with a Renewal Application. It will still be your responsibility to complete the Renewal Application and mail in with the appropriate renewal fees, postmarked before December 31st.

The remaining SWPA Zoom Virtual workshops are almost full to capacity and although I am happy to help - my time is very limited on the actual workshop days with the pre-presentation set-up, so contact me at 904.845.7133 in the days prior to the actual workshop.
